Computer intrusions, child exploitation, Internet fraud and copying of software, songs, movies and other intellectual property are a growing problem in the United States. The FBI CyberProgram investigates these and other computer and Internet crimes. Special Agent Kristine Green, supervisor of the local New Orleans FBI Cyber Program will present a three-hour CPE talk on the work they do and the crime affecting us both locally and on a national level. She will discuss the special issues related to cyber crime investigations with examples of the laws involved.

Ms. Green has been a Special Agent with the FBI for over 13 years. She worked in public corruption from 1996 - 2000, when she was assigned to the cyber crime squad. Since then, she has been involved with investigating criminal and national security cyber cases. In 2006, she became supervisor of the New Orleans FBI Cyber Squad and the CyberProgram Coordinator for the FBI in Louisiana. She holds a bachelor's from Emory University, a law degree from Temple University and is licensed to practice law in South Carolina.

- ***Information Security Program Metrics***

This publication defines information security program metrics by identifying what constitutes meaningful and actionable metrics for managing information security. An international group of senior security practitioners has researched the best and most effective approaches to information security program metrics. This publication explores emerging metric concepts and enumerates practical approaches to better manage the increasingly complex security machinery through feedback mechanisms. - ***CobiT and Application Controls: A Management Guide***

This guidance is directed to business and IT management, business process owners, developers, users, auditors, and compliance practitioners. However, it is written primarily for the business and IT community and uses business language and minimizes “audit speak.” The publication is structured based on the life cycle of application systems—implementation, operation and maintenance—and provides assurance on application controls. The concepts apply equally to new and existing legacy application systems.
